Information: 5.1 Enrollment/Waiting List for 2022-2023

VMCS continues to be fully enrolled for the current school year at 246 scholars, with 4 TKers who were underaged when enrolled. TK has 24 total scholars, with all other grade levels enrolled at 32, with the exception of Grades 2 and 5 at 31. The waiting list has now been rolled over into the 2023-2024 school year.

Information: 5.2 Enrollment/Waiting List for 2023-2024

After the drawing on March 31, 2023, all classes are full enrolled with 24 scholars in TK and 32 scholars in Grades K-6. Some of the new enrollees are still completing their enrollment packet. There is currently a waiting list of 279 for the new school year. The numbers are as follows:
