# 4. EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR REPORT -- DEBRA J. SCHROEDER

### Information: 4.1 Progress Report on New Site

There was hope that we would present to the City of Anaheim Planning Commission on December 4, 2023, to acquire the Conditional Use Permit (CUP). This has been in process for approximately a year. This meeting was cancelled and tentatively moved to December 18, 2023.

### Information: 4.2 California Community Schools Partnership (CCSPP) Planning Grant Update

Vvette LaValle attended a meeting on Friday, September 12, 2023, regarding the CCSPP Planning Grant. We are in Cohort 1, and no report is required until November 2024. When a ParentSquare Survey was sent to VMCS families, there were 30 respondents who were willing to be involved in the process of developing a plan. With a focus on community partners, VMCS has a strong start with at least 15 established partnership. There is still a strong focus on providing family support via coaching and counseling. Dr. Roque may be part of the support for our families beginning in January 2024.

# Reports: 4.3 Comparative Analysis of SBAC Results for 2022-2023

Schroeder shared Proficiency/Advanced percentage data from Vibrant Minds Charter School in Grades 3-6, which are the grade levels that take the SBAC. This data was compared with schools in the Anaheim Elementary School District, as well as other charter schools in the area. Data was also compared with schools in high socioeconomic areas. VMCS performs much better than other schools, both traditional and charter, in Anaheim and Santa Ana. However, schools in high socioeconomic areas continue to perform better. The one grade level that struggled last school year was Grade 4, even though they made some progress from Grade 3. This supports our plan to provide additional support to our Grade 5 scholars.

### Information, Reports: 4.4 Issue with the Possible Purchase of Two 15-Passenger Vans
