### THIS IS OUR SCHOOL SITE COUNCIL

Our School Site Council (SSC) is comprised of teachers, parents, and classified employees. The members work with the director to develop, review, and evaluate school improvement programs and budgets. The SSC member representatives are elected by their peers. Parents elect classified parent members (four), classified staff elects a member (one), and certificated staff elects certificated members (two). The director is also part of the SSC.

The SSC meets on a regular basis to make decisions and advise the director on the school budget, academic programs, school improvement plans, parent engagement, safety, and discipline plans.

Members of the SSC represent the families' and staff's viewpoints, decisions, and concerns at the monthly Vibrant Minds Charter School Board Meetings.
